## Software License Policy Overview

By accepting and installing the CaseWORTH™ software, you agree to be bound by the terms of the CaseWORTH Academic Software License set forth below.

CaseWORTH is licensed on a per-PC basis. CaseWORTH can be installed on only as many PCs as your school has been granted licenses. Each time a new case is created in CaseWORTH the user must select and assign an authorized instructor for that case. The school's name and instructor's name will be displayed in CaseWORTH any time that case is opened. The school's name and instructor's name will also be included on each report created by CaseWORTH. The software shall be licensed under a limited-term (typically 2 year for students) or unlimited (for schools) basis. The software will automatically cease to function at the end of that subscription term.

## Academic Software License

1. READ THIS LICENSE BEFORE USE. Please read this Academic Software License Agreement ("Academic License") before you use the product. By clicking the "Accept" button below, breaking the seal of this product, or using this product, you are accepting the terms of this Academic License.

2. Software covered by this Academic License. This Academic License covers the use of all software (the "Software"), including CaseWORTH™ software, developed by WorthMORE Software ("WMS"). This Academic License also covers the use of any and all updates and/or replacements to such software unless such updates contain a separate license.

3. License. WMS hereby grants to you the limited right to use the Software for the duration of the license term. You only own the tangible information pertaining to the Software such as documentation, the media on which the Software resides, and the data generated by the Software that is specific to your course work. WMS retains all rights, including intellectual property rights, in the Software and documentation pertaining thereto. You agree to respect all intellectual property rights owned by WMS pertaining to the Software.

4. License Term. License is granted for the period of time (two (2) years for students), or may be unlimited (for schools), as specified in the license term. The software shall not be used for any purpose beyond the license term. The software will automatically cease to function at the end of the license term.

5. Authorized Uses. This Academic License authorizes the installation and use of the Software on one (1) PC or PC-equivalent owned or leased by a student. This Academic License authorizes the installation and use of the Software on fifty (50) PCs or PC-equivalent owned or leased by the authorized school or an authorized instructor for exclusive use by the school's instructors and students. Each new file (case) created with the software must be assigned to one authorized instructor registered with WMS as an instructor employed by the authorized school.

6. PC or PC equivalent. A PC or PC equivalent is defined to be either: 1) a single-user computer operating under a single-user operating system; or 2) a single user profile operating under a multi-user operating system or environment including, but not limited to, Windows Terminal Server, Citrix or any virtual machine system.

7. Unauthorized Uses and/or Duplication Prohibited. You may create one (1) backup copy of the media on which the Software is provided and one (1) backup copy of the Software in connection with a backup of each PC on which the Software is installed. If applicable, you agree to maintain the license key or other cryptographic device accompanying the Software in strict confidence. All other uses of the Software are prohibited, including but not limited to:

- a. making the Software available for download over a public network, including but not limited to the Internet and peer-to-peer networks;
- b. installing the Software on a server for a wide area network or a local area network, excluding the data files generated by the Software and/or data maintenance software provided with the Software, if applicable;
- c. distributing the Software;
- d. copying the Software for anyone other than a currently enrolled student of the authorized instructor;
- e. reverse-engineering or disassembling the Software;
- f. modifying the Software;
- g. creating derivative works from the Software;
- h. using the software beyond the end of the license term or
- i. *using the software in the course of providing consulting services for a lawyer or law firm not possessing a current non-expired CaseWORTH Commercial Software License in their own right.*

8. Transfer. All transfers of this Academic License are prohibited. 9. Termination. This Academic License terminates immediately upon the breach of any of the terms of this Academic License.

10. Warranties and limitation on liability. WMS warrants the media on which the Software is provided for defects in workmanship and materials for ninety (90) days from the date of purchase. As remedies under this warranty, WMS will either replace the defective media or refund the original purchase price of the Software. WMS makes no other warranties, express or implied, with respect to the Software. This Academic License supersedes all other warranties made in the documentation accompanying the Software. YOU EXPRESSLY AGREE TO USE THE SOFTWARE AT YOUR OWN RISK. WMS IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY DAMAGES CAUSED BY THE SOFTWARE WHETHER OR NOT DEFECTIVE.

11. Export control. You agree that the Software is subject to restrictions and controls imposed by the United States Export Administration Act ("Act") and the regulations thereunder. You agree and certify that neither the Software, nor any direct product thereof, is being, or will be acquired, shipped, transferred or re-exported, directly or indirectly, into any country prohibited by the Act and the regulation thereunder, or will be used for any purpose prohibited by the same.

12. Governing Law. This Academic License shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Arkansas.

13. Severability. If any portion of this Academic License is declared unenforceable by a court of law, the remaining portions of this Academic License shall remain in full force and effect. The stricken provision will be deemed replaced by a provision as near in meaning to the stricken provision as allowed by law.

14. Entire Agreement. This Academic License sets forth the entire understanding between you and WMS with respect to the subject matter contained herein and may not be altered or amended except by instrument in writing executed by WMS.
